



RULES

1. EVENT ASI, Automotoclub Storico Italiano, organizes on May 3rd, 4th, 5th, 2024 an Event for historic motorcycles at Riccardo Paletti Racing Track in Varano de' Melegari (Parma). The event is open to the motorcycles built within 2002 holding a FIVA or ASI Identity Card, and to those which are in original conditions and have a historic and cultural value, at the discretion of the Board of Examiners appointed by the organizer. The event consists of a static part, where the vehicles are exposed in the paddocks of the racing track, and of a dynamic part, which is a parade on the track of groups, divided depending on the FIVA categories of age and on the technical characteristics of the vehicles.

2. RIDERS Italian and foreign riders can participate in the Event as long as they are of legal age and own a valid driver's license. The use of an approved helmet is mandatory for all categories, according to current laws (bowl helmets prohibited). The use of leather clothing, including gloves and boots, is also mandatory (in derogation of what has just been stated, for the motorcycle categories included from the origins up to 1935 only, technical Kevlar clothing with related protections may be accepted. The use of gloves and boots remains confirmed). For racing motorbikes and those built from 1970 onwards, the use of a full leather suit (alternatively the zipped two-piece) and an approved full-face helmet is mandatory. Passengers are not permitted to ride on single motorcycles. If there is a sidecar, the passenger is considered a rider and must therefore send in the registration form and pay half the rider's fee. All riders must only use the motorcycles specified in their entry form and they must not exchange them or give them to other participants. Riders on motorcycles leaking oil or with other serious technical problems, or showing unacceptable hazardous behavior on the track that puts their life and the lives of others at risk or interrupts the event can be asked to leave at any moment and removed from the track, at the final decision of the Track Manager or Event Organizers. Participants declare that they accept all the rules applied at the Circuit, committing themselves to always respecting the rules of correct and careful driving, which are aimed at preventing any danger caused to both themselves and the fellow participants. For this purpose, they provide the widest personal indemnity against the Riccardo Paletti Track, the Event Organizers and the ASI Automotoclub Storico Italiano for any damage that they might cause to third party participants.

3. PRIZES AND CLASSIFICATION Because this is not a competitive Event, there is no classification of merit, but each participant will receive a certificate in commemoration of the event.

4. INSPECTIONS The Organizers and ASI Commissioners will check personal documents and make technical inspections of the motorcycles at the Riccardo Paletti Track in Varano de' Melegari (Parma) starting Friday, May 3rd, 2024 at 8:30 am..

5. GENERAL RULES Participants undertake to respect the Covid rules in force at the time of the event. Access to the paddock area is reserved to motor vehicles registered in the event, any service vehicles and the motorcycles on display. The Organization Committee reserves the right to make any changes to the Rules that are necessary for the success of the Event, and will inform all participants of any changes made. Only registered motor vehicles and accredited journalists and photographers will be granted access to the track. Accreditation must be requested by April 10th, 2024 to the Organizers (iscrizioniasimotoshow@asifed.it) and must be shown on request to the Track Manager and Event Organizers. The Event will also be held in poor weather conditions. The Organization can prevent access to the track at any moment if it considers these conditions to be hazardous to participant safety, but it will not be required to reimburse the registration fee. It is strictly forbidden to park any type of vehicle or van in the area immediately in front of the pits. If they are parked, they will be removed by tow truck at the expense of the violators.

6. LIABILITY For damage to possessions or persons that might derive from the organization and course of events or third parties, the participant, at the moment of registration, explicitly waives all legal actions and/or claims against the Riccardo Paletti Track, the Event Organizers and the ASI Automotoclub Storico Italiano, and their President or Legal Representatives.

7. ACCEPTANCE OF REGISTRATION AND MOTORCYCLES The main purpose of the event is to illustrate the history of motorcycles in motion from their origins to 2002; therefore, in case that two motorcycles are requested to be registered, it is preferable, where possible, that the second motorcycle has at least 10 years gap of construction compared to the first. The acceptance of the registration of Motorcycle number 1 and/or Motorcycle number 2 is in any case related to wide parameters of judgement, such as for example: possession of the ASI (Targa Oro) or FIVA Identity Card, availability of places in the heats, historical value of the vehicle, state of conservation, inclusion in specific topics, etc. **Acceptance of the entry of Motorcycle number 1 and/or Motorcycle number 2 remains in any case subject to the unquestionable judgment of the Examining Commission and the Organisers.**

8. ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES These rules are an integral part of the General Rules for use of the track and facilities of the Riccardo Paletti Track in Varano de' Melegari (Pr), which are on display on the notice board. Copies of the General Rules may be requested. The registered participant completely accepts both Rules and must scrupulously adhere to all the norms within them.
